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





The above said SURAIDEO PRASAD EDUCATIONAL WELFARE TRUST & will receive contributions, ave thousand solv me all to be contributions.

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




subscriptions, donations, benequests to be received or any moveable or immovable property to be gifted infavour of the trust or so acquired in future by the trust for benevolent, welfare and haritable purpose and other purposes as described in its objects and aims, subject to the Trusts power and provision contained and rules and by laws laid down hereinafter in this deed of Trust. And whereas the said setteler having been motivated by pious wish and desire and benevolent consideration for relieving the sufferings of ailing poors and for supporting education and to inculacate the spirit of co-operation & good citizen amongst the public in general, and to provide education/advance education and training and to work for the moral and cultural upliftment of youngsters of the society and advancement of another objects of general public utility.

- (b) To further promote establishment of scientific/commercial/professional educational institutions by all lawful means.
- (c) To manage centre for adult education, schools, to establish library, reading rooms having proper books, magazines, periodicals and daily newspapers etc.
- (d) To extend special facility to backwards, downtroden, Schedule castes and schedule Tribes, Vikalangs and orphans, poor and needy etc.
- (e) To also exted vocational education like sangit and lalit kala particulary to girls of lower status and backward in education and culture etc.
- (f) To establish and start from time to time according to crying need of the society any such other institutions in which maintenance of hostel for boys/girls under good cares and patrons in addition to the institution importing education becomes must.


(g) To start relief work in times of a time, flood and fire and extend food and drinking water and medical facilities to the needy.




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- (h) To eneter into any agreement with government, semigovt. authority under centre or state, Municipal local or other bodies which may seen conclusive to the furtherance of all or any of the objectives and aims of this Trust and obtain from such sources and right privileges, assistance and concesseions which this Trust may think fit and desirable.
- (i) To pay by way of honourarium, salary or fees to the persons so engaged for and on behalf of trust or to any other person in return for any services rendered to the trust in fulfiling its aims and objects.
- (j) To ward of and to have proper watch against the evils and wrong doers of the society and to save the poors and needy from extortion, suppression and oppression particularly in matter of marriage, dowry etc.
- (k) To arrange for the uplift of helpless, unemployed youngsters by creating opportunities for works and jobs.
- (1) To arrange training of fine arts as sewing, painting designing etc. to the women folk in particular and other allied training for the self earning and to earn the levelihood by the have nots, widown and destitutes.
- (m) To encourage and foster in the society all the benefical scheme taken up by the govt. for upliftment of the mass or particularly among the have nots.
- (n) To do all other things as are incidental or conductive of the attaiment of the aims and object to the trust out of its own trust fund and income from outside in shape of donations, contributions and subscription or grants from any social reformers or bodies or govt. etc.
- (o) To organise seminars and other functions.
- (p) To provide medical aid, organise medical camps, run clinics for the public.
- (q) To donate or assist any other organisation/trust having similar objects, and engaged in public services.





- (r) To establish library, reading room, auditorium for public.
- (s) To regulate correspondence courses for those who are uanble to attend class room courses.
- (u) To inculcate awareness among the children to live life free of superstition and negative thought patterns.
- (v) To develop awareness among the mass to improve the environment around them pollution free such as organise tree plantationetc.
- (w) To impart intentive training in indoor & outdoor sports viz Judo Karate, swimming etc. and other curricular activities viz sculpture, music, photography & any forms of arts and craft to students for their all round development.
- (x) To construct community hall etc. for the public at large.
- (y) To promote agriculture, dairy, poulty, fishery etc.
- (z) And any other activities which the board of Trustees decides to do for benefits of public in general.
- 4. **Co-opted or Nominated members :-** The other two members will be by co-option, from amongst the public, to be co-opted by the permanent members by consensus. The duration of such co-opted members shall be of three years i.e. retirement. They are eligible for reco-option. Any vacancy due to death, resignation or expulsion due to doing against the trust interest, will be filled up by co-opting another person or persons of similar status and category.
- (5) For all category of members, they should be at least above the age of 21 years having sound mind and good character having full faith in trust and in its aims and objects.
- (6) Meeting of Board of Trustee: An ordinary meeting of Trustees can be called annualy or six monthly by a notice, 15 days prior to the meeting, which shall indicate the date, time, place, and agenda and 30% of total strength of the trustees shall constitute the quorum. An adjourned meeting shall not require any quorum.



- (7) Power of Trustees: Trustees shall have full power, authority to administer the Trust property.
- To receive, collect and enforce recovery of all money due or payable to the Trust and grant necessary receipts and discharge therefore.
  - To receive gifts & donation in cash or in kind. (ii)
- To appoint, terminate, suspend and otherwise deal with the employees/committees/subcommittee/Executive Committee/ Managing Committee.
- To appeal and act before courts, tribunals, public offices (c) etc.
- To institute, prosecute and defend all suits and other legal. (d) proceedings.
- To incur all necessary expenses from the income of the trust in connection with the Trust and its management. The corpus of the trust shall remain intact always.
- To apply property and funds for the objects of the Trust. (f)
- To purchase, sale, hire, lease or invest the trust fund (g) (i) or any part there of in land, movables, immovables.
- To borrow monies, take loans from individual/ financial institution/Govt. and others on such terms & condition, subject to payment of interest of otherwise as the Board of trustee . may consider necessary or desirable.
- Generally to do all such acts, deeds and funds as may be (h) required to fullfill the purposes of the Trust and matters incidental thereto.
- Extra ordinary and requisitioned meeting of the (8) Trustees: The board may on its own initaitive cas call extra ordinary meeting of the Trustees on the written request of trustees constituting 75% of the total members of the Trust.

The quorum for such meeting shall be the same as for the ordinary meeting of the Board of Trustees.
















- (a) Adopt the annual report of the Trust.
- (b) Accept the audited accounts prepared by the authroised or appointed auditors.
- (c) Review the work of office bearers and its any sub committee or subordinate body if any:-
- (d) Consider such matters as and when referred to it by any trustee.
- (e) Elect every three years, members of the board of Trustees as provided above by co-option.
- (f) Elect member of board of Advisers, from the well wihsers amongst the public.
- (g) **Chairman** Chairman will preside over all meetings. He may inspect any office and institution under its control and can supervise any functioning and working.

Secretary:- The secretary as per the direction shall call the meeting of Board of Trustees. The secretary shall be responsible for the up keeping of all records, prepare annual budget of the trust for approval by the board of trustees.


The secretary shall sincerely & faithfully execute and carry out the directions of the Board of Trustees and will be responsible for all correspondence.

The Secretary shall attend to the day to day affairs of the Trust and shall exercise such power and perform such duties as the Trustees may vest in him from time to time.


**Treasurer:** The treasurer will be incharge of the cash Accounts of the trust and shall be always answerable to the Board of trustee.

Managing Trustees: - The Board of trustee may authorise any one from amongst themselves to act as a managing trustee.

(10) Sources of Finance: Through the Chief donations of the settlor and donation, subcription and grants etc. from any individual, organisation semigovt. and govt. etc.



- (11) **Operation of Accounts:** All money/fund of Trust shall be deposited in a nationalised Bank as per resolution assed by the Board of Trustees. Its operation will be done by the signature of the Chairman/Secretary and Trasure, or by any two trustees jointly as per the decision of Board of Trustees.
- (12) The Trust shall pay all costs, charge and expenses incidental to the management, administration and execution of the trust or of its any subordinate offices or institution and the management of institutions shall be every where headed by the committee/subcommittee as formed by the board of trustees.
- (13) That Trust shall get maintained a regular account starting from 1st April and ending on 31st March i.e. financial year shall be the accounting year and not the calender year. It shall be duly audited by the registered or chartered accountant annually.
- (14) **Decisions:** The decision of the board of Trustees shall be by consensus and its verdict should be obeyed and carried out by all the officials and Trustees.
- (15) Amendments: If in the opinion of the Trustees, circumstances so require, the trustes may by two third majority make any amendment in the above stated manner make rules for its working and functioning as they consider necessary for better and efficient management supervision and control of the Trust activities.
- (16) In the event of dissolution or winding up of the trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the trustees, but the same shall be transferred to another public trust, society, association, whose object are similar to those of this trust.
- of the assets against all legal or other actions, costs of litigation, claims and liabilities arising out of the need to defend the Trust and its properties and done in good faith by the Trustees in the discharge of their duties as Trustees.
